By-law 11.3 E: USRA PRIME OF LIFE ACHIEVEMENT AWARDS COMMITTEE

Delete: "This Committee shall make recommendations to the Executive to honour members of the Association who, after retirement, have made outstanding scholarly, artistic or service contributions. Such contributions should have been recognized by international, national, provincial or local bodies." Replace with the following: E.1 This Committee shall make recommendations to the Executive in accordance with the "Procedures for the Prime of Life Achievement Awards."

By-law 11.3 F: Add: "USRA Committee for Honorary Degree Nominations"

Description "This committee shall assist the Office of the University Secretary in encouraging nominations of candidates for honorary degrees."
