Welcome 'Retirees'!

The University of Saskatchewan Retirees Association (USRA) defines *retirees* quite broadly:

- Retirees include all those who have retired from the University, including from federated and affiliated colleges and those employed under research grants and contracts.
- Retirees include all those who have left positions at the University, who were employed for six years or more and have reached the age of 55 years.


1973 USRFA University of Saskatchewan Retired Faculty Association established for four years to upgrade pensions of retired faculty.

1989 USRA University of Saskatchewan Retirees Association revived from USRFA to be a voice for retired faculty and administrators, including those from federated and affiliated colleges.

1996 USNARA University of Saskatchewan Non-Academic Retirees
Association formed by staff whose pension benefit was paid from the Non-Academic Pension Plan; primarily CUPE 1975 and those who moved to/are in other employee groups but opted to stay in Non-Academic Plan.

2017 USRA + USNARA USNARA dissolved by membership because of declining enrolment. USRA voted to welcome all members of USNARA to USRA and 136 have joined. The USRA constitution was revised to reflect merger, and USRA eligibility expanded to include those who left a University after **six or more years** and are at least **55 years of age.**

2021 MOU Memorandum of Understanding signed between the University and the USRA, accepting the USRA definition of retirees, asserting that retirees who are not USask graduates are considered **Associate Alumni**, and affirming that the USRA represents **all retirees**, not only USRA members.





- To promote and safeguard the welfare and interests of retirees.
- To foster a continuing relationship among retirees and between retirees and the University.
- To communicate with retirees and the University on shared goals.
- To provide intellectual and social activities for members.
- To promote USRA objectives to employees approaching retirement.
- To collaborate with retiree associations at other Canadian universities and other organizations in areas of common interest.

USRA objectives are facilitated through agreement with the University.

Treasurer




Serves as chief executive officer of the Association.


